Australia, Colombard Chardonnay 3.90/5.50/15.95
A popular Australian blend of Colombard and Chardonnay, this wine displays tropical fruit flavours with good length and fruitiness.

Trig Point, SA 2007

Uruguay, Sauvignon 3.15/5.80/16.95
The cool Atlantic blows over the vineyards of San Jose to deliver a wine that shows green pepper and citrus notes.

Catamayor 2008/9

France, Chardonnay 4.35/6.20/17.95
Sun-drenched peachy fruits are the hallmarks of this well rounded Chardonnay.

Robert Skalli, Languedoc 2006/7

France, Sauvignon Sémillon 5.05/7.15/20.95
Refreshing crispness derived from the Sauvignon with fuller fruit from the Sémillon combine to form a very easily drunk wine.

Chateau Billot Blanc, Bergerac 2006/7

Italy, Pinot Grigio 4.15/5.80/16.95
One of the best examples of why Pinot Grigio has come from nowhere to be the most popular white wine consumed in the UK.

Botter Ca'lunghetta, 2008

South Africa, Sauvignon Blanc 4.85/6.80/19.95
A fresh, bright and grassy nose with bags of fruitiness. The palate is broad, but still fresh and bright with flavours of fig and tropical fruits.

Lomond, Cape Agulhas 2007

France, Viognier 22.00
Intensely aromatic white with a bouquet of elderflower, citrus and honey. Palate is medium dry with a ripe, honeyed apple flavour and a zesty finish.

Domaine Fabregues 'Amelie' Viognier, France 2009

Italy, Pinot Grigio 24.95
A real peach of a wine for those who have really enjoyed the Ca'lunghetta we now present the next sublime experience for PG fans. An exquisite example.

"Le Rosse" Tommasi, Veneto 2006/7

Italy, Garganega 21.00
The Garganega has intense aromas of almond blossom, orange zest and vanilla dominate the nose. This stunning wine is full bodied with ripe fruit, clean acidity and a long finish with mineral notes.

Vinea, Garganega, IGT, Veneto 2009

France, Pinot Gris 21.95
One of the ultimate wines to enjoy with spicy food. A close relative of Pinot Grigio but with the flavour really pumped up. Knocks spots off standard PG!!

Gustave Lorentz, Alsace, 2005

France, Chardonnay 24.95
For those who like their Chardonnay with a touch of elegance. This example from one of Chablis' top producers shows refinement with light clean apple notes.

Petit Chablis Moreau, Burgundy 2006/7

New Zealand, Sauvignon Blanc 27.90
Outstanding Sauvignon Blanc from the Marlborough region in the south island. Tropical fruits balanced with fine minerality and good acidity and a long expressive finish.

Green Lip Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough 2008

rosé wine

Spain, Garnacha Rosé 4.60/6.50/18.95
Seductive colour and seductive soft berry fruits in harmony with a hint of spice.

Vina Real Rosado Rioja 2007/8

Chile, Cabernet Rosé 4.60/6.50/18.95
Serious firm style for food displaying the deep cassis fruit but without the robust tannins of its big brother, the full red version!

Torreón de Paredes 2007/9

South Africa, Shiraz Rosé 4.60/6.50/18.95
Salmon pink in colour, this Rose is bursting full of light summer fruits. Delicious Rose which is sure to be a hit with our customers. This was awarded 3 stars in the 2010 John Platter guide.

Beaumont Raouls, Bot River 2008/9

Italy, Pinot Grigio blush 4.35/6.15/17.95
First it was white Pinot Grigio now its pink cousin is stealing the limelight. Easy drinking - not too dry.

Romato, Botter 2007/8

Argentina, Merlot Rosé 4.35/6.15/17.95
With a superb depth of colour, this is a delicious young fruity wine with attractive strawberry overtones.

Goyenechea Winery 2007/8

red wine

Australia, Shiraz Cabernet 3.90/5.50/15.95
Spicy, berry flavours completed by a touch of mint, dominate this wine. The warm, ripe, savoury fruit results in a soft, rounded palate showing great length.

Trig Point, 2006

Italy, Merlot 4.15/5.80/16.95
The Merlot is more at home in France, however, this Italian Merlot from Veneto offers a lighter version for those who prefer their palates to be caressed!

Botter Ca'lunghetta 2007/8

Chile, Cabernet 4.60/6.60/18.95
Serious big flavours from a well respected Chilean family vineyard. Classic blackcurrant flavours.

Torreón De Paredes, 2007

South Africa, Merlot 4.85/6.80/19.95
Smooth and fruity on the nose which delivers an elegant and well balanced wine with hints of spice and chocolate. A fantastic Merlot.

Lomond, Cape Agulhas 2005

Italy, Corvina 5.60/7.80/23.00
These low yielding classic aromas of cherries and red berries with hints of vanilla and cinnamon from oak ageing. It is full bodied with great structure.

Vinea, Corvina, IGT, Veneto, 2007

Spain, Tempranillo 22.95
Well mixed fruit and creamy oak - a mix that the Spanish have perfected in Rioja.

Vina Real Crianza, Rioja 2005

France, Pinot Noir 23.95
Described by one leading author as the ultimate Vin de Pays Pinot Noir.

Domaine Valmoissine, Louis Latour, Burgundy 2006/7

Australia, Shiraz 22.95
These low yielding Shiraz vines produce a wine with a high concentration of flavours. With flavours of liquorice and chocolate.

Echo Point Shiraz, Limestone Coast 2006/7

France, Gamay 22.95
A soft, subtle red with a wonderful aroma of fresh summer fruits and soft tannins.

Côte de Brouilly, Henry Fessy, Beaujolais 2008/9

Spain, Tempranillo 5.75/8.15/23.95
From the neighbouring region to Rioja - an easy drinking style that combines full berry fruit with hints of creamy vanilla.

Bodegas Artajona, Navarra 2005/6

Argentina, Malbec 28.95
For many years a secondary grape in Bordeaux, here in Gaucho country it excels. A wine for carnivores! Robust yet with abundance of dark plummy fruit.

Quinta Generacion, Goyenechea 2005/6

France, Châteauneuf du Pape 49.95
The Châteauneuf du Pape is the jewel and the roots of Maison Bouachon, established more than a century ago in the papal summer residence of Southern Rhône. The wine is made from Grenache (60%), Syrah (30%), Mourvèdre and a small proportion of other typical varieties. Small parcels are harvested by hand, before a long period of traditional maceration, ageing and blending. This is the jewel of our list and it is well worth its place.

La Tiare du Pape, Maison Bouachon 2007/8

sparkling wine

Italy, Prosecco di Voldobbiadene 18.95
Extremely elegant, more Ferrari than Fiat.

Spain, Cava Brut Vallformossa 18.95
Classic European sparkler with a slight blush.

Italy, Pinot Grigio Ca'lunghetta Spumante 21.95
As with still Pinot Grigio - very easy to drink, soft flavours with a smooth effervescence.

Italy, Pinot Grigio Blush Ca'lunghetta Spumante 21.95
The pink sparkler of the UK's favourite wine.

Italy, Rocco Prosecco DOC Brut Italy 21.95
A perfect aperitif or cocktail wine.

Italy, Rocco Rosé Brut Italy 24.95
A very fine and fruity wine - elegant and intense.
